# LINEBERGER FAMILY ART SCHOLARSHIP

# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Lincoln County Rotary Student Loan Fund is dedicated to the education of our citizens in Lincoln County. With the generosity of the Walter & Sissy Lineberger family and the establishment of the Lineberger Family Art Scholarship Fund, in memory of Mr. Walter Lineberger, longtime Lincolnton Rotarian and his wife, Mrs. Sissy Lineberger, the Lincoln County Rotary Student Loan Fund will be awarding two (2) but not to exceed four (4) Scholarships per year to Lincoln County Students. The maximum total funds to be distributed among all recipients in a particular year will be \$5,000.00. (Typically, the scholarships are awarded to 2 students at \$2500.00 each, but circumstance may vary depending upon the pool of applicants.) These scholarships will be eligible to Lincoln County students that are seniors in high school, who have taken at least one class on campus in the area of fine arts or have taken private art classes, who have demonstrated artistic talent in the visual arts, and are planning to pursue a degree in visual arts, visual art education or visual art history by enrolling full time in an accredited community college or university.

The recipients will be decided by a committee made up of 2 members of the Lineberger family (or their designees), and three members of the Lincoln County Rotary Student Loan Fund, Inc., striving to have one representative from the Rotary Club of Lincolnton, of which Mr. Walter Lineberger was a longstanding member.

These funds are separate and apart from the loans funded by the efforts of the Lincoln County Rotarians through the Rotary Auction for Education.

### REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING A LINEBERGER FAMILY ART SCHOLARSHIP.

- 1. Must be a Lincoln County High School Senior who has taken at least one class on campus in the area of fine arts, or has taken private art classes (written acknowledgement from your private art teacher will be required).
- 2. Must have demonstrated abilities in the visual arts.
- 3. Must have a 2.75 cumulative GPA (transcript is required) when you graduate from high school.
- 4. Must provide proof of admission and intend to enrolled as a full time student, (12 semester hours) in the academic year following high school graduation pursuing a degree in visual arts, visual art education or visual art history and must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 your 1<sup>st</sup> semester in your accredited community college or university.
- 5. Must submit a portfolio of three (3) finished original art products by the application. They are not required to be mounted or matted. Once the art is submitted, they will remain in the hands of the Lincoln County Rotary Student Loan Fund, Inc. until the selection process has been completed.
- 6. Must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from current teachers.
- 7. If you are under 18, you must have a parent/guardian to sign the application with you.
- 8. If chosen, student must be willing to attend a Rotary Club of Lincolnton (Monday at noon) meeting where they and their submitted pieces will be acknowledged.
- 9. On a separate page, please submit a 100 word essay telling us why you should receive the Lineberger Family Art Scholarship.
- 10. Application must be filled out completely with a current transcript and proof of acceptance attached (if you are a graduating high school senior) or the application will be rejected.

*Application must be postmarked* on or before May 11th (or received before May 11<sup>th</sup>) or applicant will not be eligible for consideration. Official post office postmarks dated May 11<sup>th</sup> or before are acceptable proof of timeliness.

## RULES GOVERNING THE LINEBERGER FAMILY ART SCHOLARSHIP

1. The scholarship shall be awarded on a one (1) time basis, and there will be no re-submission of an application in following years unless otherwise deemed eligible and necessary by the committee.

2. Funds will be distributed to your school of choice (not the recipient) only after showing proof of attendance with the stated guidelines above including a transcript after completion of recipient's first full time semester.

- 4. \_\_100 word essay is included.
- 5. \_\_\_\_2 letters of recommendation by teachers are included.
- 6. \_\_\_\_3 original applicant pieces of art are ready to be delivered to committee.
- 7. \_\_\_Written acknowledgement from art teacher if private art classes were taken in lieu of high school classes.
- 8. \_\_\_\_Application is signed by applicant and parent/guardian if applicant is under 18.
- 9. \_\_Please make sure postmark date is legible. Applications received after May 11<sup>th</sup> without a May 11<sup>th</sup> postmark date or an illegible postmark received after May 11<sup>th</sup> will not be considered. (Only an official US Postal postmark is acceptable proof.) It is suggested that you go to the post office and ask them to postmark it so you can verify that it is legible.
